

Requirements to be a Mentor for Castellino Training WS facilitators-in-Training

- Graduate from a Castellino Foundation Training
- Be approved as a WS facilitator whose WSs will be credited for the Foundation Training requirements.
- Have offered WSs over a long enough time, having received sufficient personal and group supervision to become skilled in being with participants, assistants and co-facilitators in a wide variety of situations. Generally this is 25 or more womb surrounds but depends on the individual's other qualifications.
- The person should have experience supervising individuals or 2-person teams who are offering WSs. This can be by taking on assistants and co-facilitators not as experienced as yourself and by offering supervision as privately requested.
- At least one of the WSs offered by potential mentors must be offered as the solo facilitator.
- Complete at least one series of group supervision with Ray or Mary/Tara either as a participant or as an observer. These have been a series of four 2.5 hour sessions offered once a month. For very experienced Womb Surround facilitators, this requirement may be modified to attending the first or more of a 4-part series of group supervision with Mary and Tara co-facilitating as an observer with the option of attending the other 3 parts of the series.
- Be willing to take on assistant(s) for your womb surrounds with the potential to have them co-facilitate with you in offering womb surround(s). The mentor makes decisions about what a potential mentee needs to do with them in terms of taking womb surrounds, assisting womb surrounds before offering to co-facilitate a womb surround. It is understood that the mentor will be the person in charge of the womb surround and the mentee is a facilitator-in-training.
